The Embassy of India, Amman is pleased to announce Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR), New Delhi, scholarships for 02 (TWO) meritorious applicants for either undergraduate (Bachelors degree), Masters Degree or a Doctoral programme in universities and educational institutions in India under ICCR's General Scholarship Scheme (GSS) for the academic year 2022-23. The scholarships include enrollment and course fees, besides a fixed amount of living expenses. The scholarships are granted for the full duration of the course.

The selected candidate(s) will be provided a scholarship package to cover tuition/ college fees and a part of the cost of boarding & lodging in India for the duration of studies/research work in a recognized Indian University or higher educational institution. The cost of **air travel from Jordan to India and back, will be borne by the Government of India, however cost of medial insurance policy is to be borne by the selected applicant.**
